

RESOLUTION NO. 25-46

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA; APPROVING UTILIZING BROWARD COUNTY CONTRACT NO. PNC2129632B1 AND AUTHORIZING THE CONCRETE AND ASPHALT RESTORATION SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH CONCRETE WORKS & PAVING, INC., IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$256,066.55 FOR THE 2025-2026 FISCAL YEAR AND PURCHASE ORDERS MADE DURING THE 2026-2027 FISCAL YEAR SHALL NOT EXCEED THE BUDGETED FUNDS IN THE RESPECTIVE LINE ITEMS FOR THE 2026-2027 FISCAL YEAR; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTION NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2025, the Broward County Commission approved and entered into the Concrete and Asphalt Restoration Services Agreement with Concrete Works & Paving, Inc. (the “Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, the City’s Utilities Department is in need of the services provided by Concrete Work and Paving Inc., under the Agreement to provide for the repair and maintenance of roadway system, sidewalks, and driveways, landscape and pavement marking restoration, and traffic maintenance projects, among other important public work projects within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has worked with Concrete Works & Paving, Inc., in the past and is pleased with the level of services and professionalism that Concrete Works & Paving, Inc., provided to the City; and

WHEREAS, the Sec. 2-258(f) of the City’s Procurement Code authorizes the purchase of services under a contract awarded by another government by formal competitive process; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of Sec. 2-258(f) of the City's Procurement Code, the City's Purchasing Agent has determined that time, expense, and present marketplace factors make it financially advantageous to utilize the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that entering into the Concrete and Asphalt Restoration Services Agreement with Concrete Works & Paving, Inc., is in the best interests of the City and will protect the health, safety and welfare of its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA:

Section 1: **Recitals Adopted.** That each of the above stated recitals is hereby adopted and confirmed. All exhibits attached hereto and incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

Section 2: That the City Commission finds that entering into the Concrete and Asphalt Restoration Services Agreement with Concrete Works & Paving, Inc., is in the best interests of the City and will protect the health, safety and welfare of its residents.

Section 3. That the appropriate City officials are authorized and directed to execute the Concrete and Asphalt Restoration Services Agreement and to take any and all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.

Section 4. **Conflicts.** All resolutions inconsistent or in conflict herewith shall be and are hereby repealed insofar as there is conflict or inconsistency.

Section 5. **Severability.** If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this resolution.

Section 6. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and adoption by the City Commission.
