SUBJECT: Appointment to the Education Advisory Board - **Commissioner Shrouder**

BACKGROUND OF ITEM:

The Education Advisory Board (EAB) was reestablished by the City Commission on April 8, 2014, via Resolution 14-4-2, to serve as a vital link between the City of Cooper City and the educational community. Established by the City Commission, the board advises on matters affecting the quality of education for Cooper City residents and the conditions of educational facilities within the City. Its purpose is to promote the continued success of local schools and ensure that students, teachers, and families have a strong voice in shaping educational priorities.

The board provides recommendations to the City Commission on a wide range of issues, including K–12, vocational, alternative, and adult education in both public and private settings. Members also monitor School Board actions and serve as liaisons with administrators, parents, civic associations, and the business community. By reviewing needs and gathering community input, the Education Advisory Board plays an important role in supporting quality education across all levels in our city.

Commissioner Shrouder appoints Casey Brown to the Education Advisory Board.
