- The Official Seal is codified in City Code
- It represents Cooper City in legal, ceremonial and historical contexts
- Appears on ordinances, proclamations, official documents and formal materials

The Opportunity

- The current Seal lacks visual connection to City history and growth
- A contest can engage residents in designing a symbol reflecting where we have been and who we are today
- Create a modern Seal while honoring our history



What We Aim to Achieve

- Reflect Cooper City's history and growth
- Capture civic pride and community identity
- Create a timeless, adaptable design

Creative Freedom Without Sacrificing

Tradition

- Including our incorporation date: June 20, 1959
- Required text: City of Cooper City | Florida
- Designers encouraged to draw inspiration from agricultural roots, residential charm and forward-looking spirit

Contest Structure

- Open to Cooper City residents only
- Digital submissions required
- Images generated with use of artificial intelligence (AI) must be disclosed
- Designs determined to contain copyrighted materials, trademarked imagery or non-original work will be disqualified
- Artwork Release Form must be completed (no monetary compensation)
- Potential community survey for input on finalist designs
- City Commission retains final decision
- Final design adopted by ordinance
- *City reserves the right to extend, modify, or cancel the contest if necessary*
