**New Quint 28 Update:** The vehicle was completed, and a final build inspection was conducted at Pierce in Appleton, Wisconsin February 25<sup>th</sup> – 27<sup>th</sup>. The Fleet Manager Victor Goizueta and I thoroughly evaluated the vehicle and found only minor issues that required correction. We expect delivery mid-March. **NEW Rescue 28 Update:** The vehicle was inspected on Wednesday, March 5<sup>th</sup>. Although some of the deficiencies had been addressed, many of the outstanding items had not been corrected. Due previous experiences of lengthy delays in the manufacturer's corrections, the vehicle was accepted. BSO Fire Fleet mechanics will be required to facilitate the correction of the remaining deficiencies. The vehicle will be at BSO Fire Fleet (6700 Powerline Road, Ft. Lauderdale) until it is ready for frontline service.

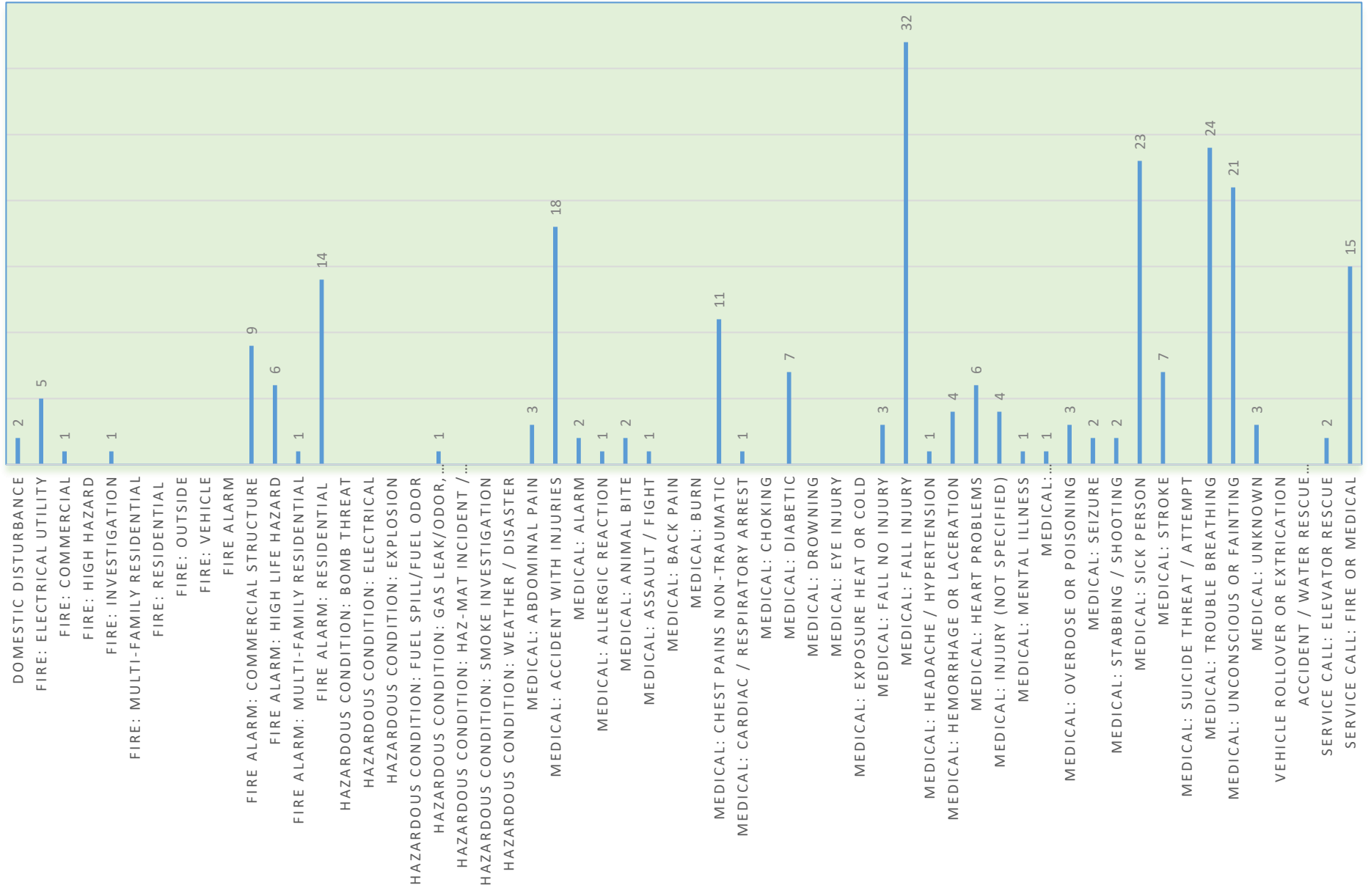

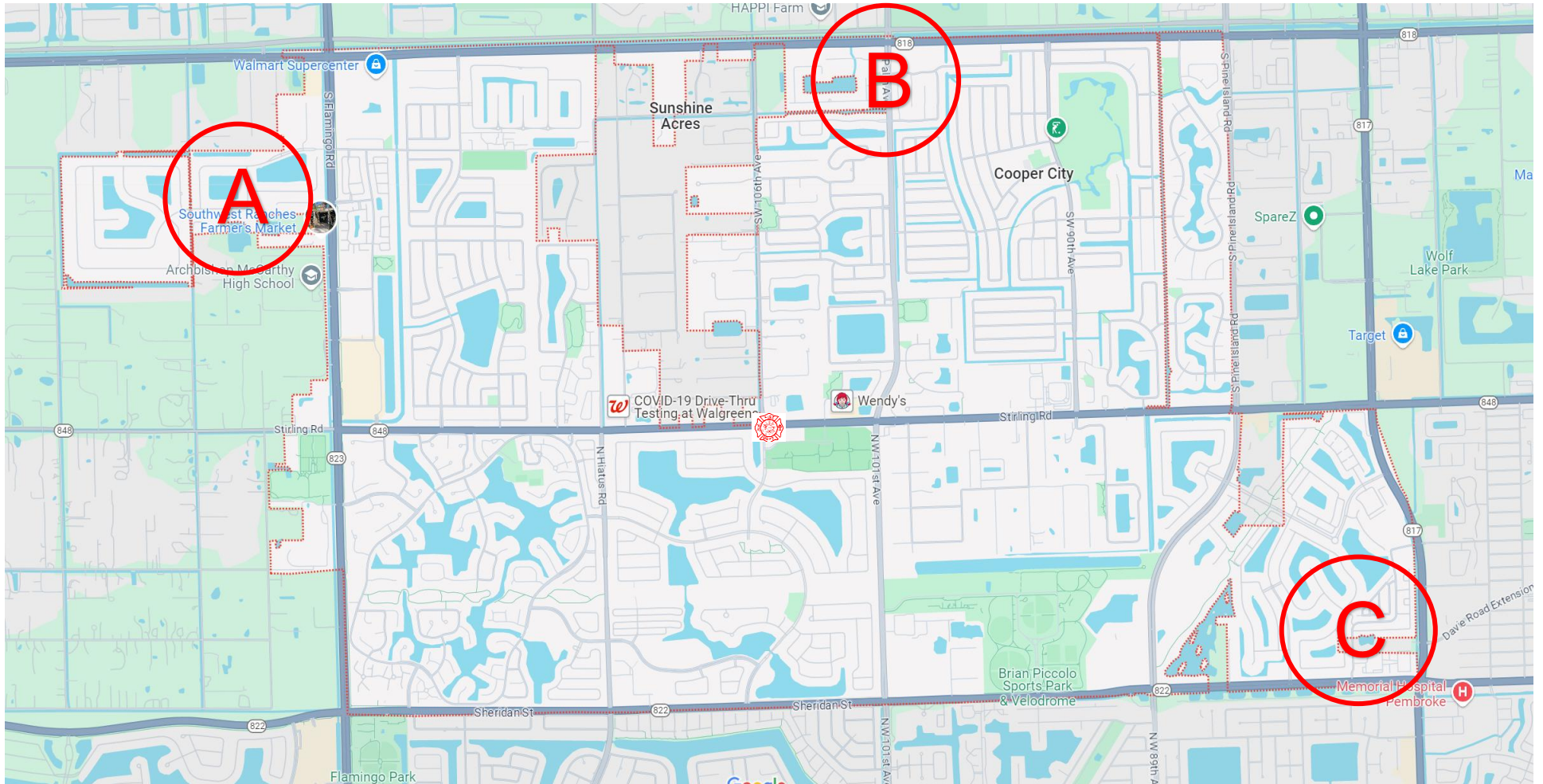
