

CITY COMMISSION ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION

TITLE: Resolution 22-16 – (Utilities)

SUBJECT: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY,

FLORIDA, APPROVING AND ACCEPTING THE OWNERSHIP OF THE WATER AND SANITARY SEWER IMPROVEMENTS, DEDICATION OF WATER AND SANITARY SEWER EASEMENTS, RELEASE OF PERFORMANCE IMPROVEMENT BOND AND ACCEPTING MAINTENANCE BOND ASSOCIATED WITH MONTERRA ACTIVE ADULT RESIDENCES DEVELOPMENT PROJECT FOR THE PROPERTY GENERALLY LOCATED AT 3991 NW 82ND AVENUE, COOPER CITY, FLORIDA; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING

FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Commission approve and accept ownership of the water and sewer systems and dedication of water and sewer utility easements associated with the Monterra Active Adult Residences Development Project, located at 3991 NW 82nd Avenue, Cooper City, FL 33024.

Staff further recommends that the Commission approve the release of two (2) Performance Improvement Bonds in the form of two (2) irrevocable Letters of Credit, one in the amount of \$1,225,601.30 for paving and drainage improvements with Central Broward Water Control District ("District") as co-obligee, and the other in the amount of \$181,755.20 for water and wastewater improvements, and accept cash Maintenance Bonds in the form of Cashier's Checks in the amounts of \$306,400.33 and \$45,438.80 respectively, representing 25% of the two (2) Letters of Credit. Both Letters of Credit are expiring on June 3, 2022.

BACKGROUND OF ITEM:

The City Commission gave final approval to the above project at their November 19, 2019 meeting. The improvements included 1,652 feet of water mains, 417 feet of gravity sewer mains, and related appurtenances, which were required to be dedicated to the City upon satisfactory completion of the construction along with necessary utility easements. Pursuant to Sec. 24-82 of the City Code, the developer provided a Performance Improvement Bond in the form of two (2) Letters of Credit from PNC Bank as mentioned above. Sec. 24-82 of the City Code also requires that after the construction is completed and accepted by the City Engineer, the Performance

Improvement Bond can be reduced to a Maintenance Bond to 25% of the original Performance Bond amount to guaranty maintenance of the improvements for one year.

ANALYSIS:

Water, wastewater, paving and drainage improvements have been constructed in accordance with the City-approved plans and are acceptable to the City Engineer's office.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact to the budget. Upon Commission approval, the City will release the two (2) irrevocable Letters of Credit issued by PNC Bank as follows:

Paving & Drainage

Release PNC Bank Letter of Credit, No. 18133206-00-000, in the amount of \$1,225,601.30

Water & Sewer

Release PNC Bank Letter of Credit, No. 18133207-00-000, in the amount of \$181,755.20

In exchange, the City will accept cash Maintenance Bonds in the form of Cashier's Checks in the amounts of \$306,400.33 and \$45,438.80.
