APRIL 27, 2021 at 6:30 PM**

**PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

Mayor Ross opened the meeting at 6:30 PM and Judith Richards, Commander of American Legion Post 321 led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

**PUBLIC SPEAKING**

**Open Public Meeting**

**Agenda Concerns**

Andrew Gross, 5010 Regency Isles Way, spoke on the importance of having a Public Safety Advisory Board.

Mayor Ross read a letter from Maxine Nicely thanking the commission for birthday flowers.

Jim Federici, 3751 Ottawa Lane, asked why the City is responsible for backflow certifications.

Assistant Utilities Director Chad Bergeron explained it is state mandated and the City takes responsibility to ensure all businesses are in compliance with DEP guidelines. Mr. Federici believes the businesses should be required to pay for the certifications.

Commissioner Pulcini would like to see how much the City is paying. Mayor Ross asked for the item to be placed on the agenda with backup.

**BOARD/ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS**

Monthly Financial Report/ Midyear Financial Review – **Finance**

CFO Sandra Bridgeman spoke on the midyear financial review.

Commissioner Pulcini spoke on a discrepancy in the water and sewer utility fund. CFO Bridgeman explained it is a rollover. He also spoke on proposed budget dates and how they should not conflict with the County's dates.

Commissioner Shrouder asked for the difference between a forecast and a projection. Commissioner Pulcini answered that a forecast is the presumption that there will be no change and a projection is the presumption that there is change.

Commissioner Shrouder would like to keep the review as an updated item.

Commissioner Pulcini would like to keep the review updated on the website.

Commissioner Shrouder advised there were transfers done in the Utilities Enterprise Fund without notification to Commission. City Attorney Horowitz advised of the Ordinance that speaks to notification of transfers. Commissioner Shrouder would like clarification on notification.

Commissioner Pulcini proposed to amend the ordinance for notify for transfer between budgetary funds and not departments.

Commissioner Meltzer advised the Commission asked for a transfer report and that it is in the monthly financial report backup.

Commissioner Shrouder would like to see intra-fund transfers.

Commissioner Green stated that the Commission is notified every time monies are spent in the City.

Commissioner Pulcini asked for the statutory requirement for noticing budget amendments on the City's website. City Attorney Horowitz advised there is a notification.

Commissioner Pulcini explained that residents are notified on Commission approved budget amendments but would like notification to residents for transfers as well.

### **Motion to approve agreement with Berry Dunn for Strategic Planning Consulting Services – Administration**

**MOTION:** Commissioner Green moved to approve an agreement with Berry Dunn for Strategic Planning Consulting Services. Commissioner Meltzer seconded the motion which prevailed by a unanimous roll call vote (5-0).

**Discussion on appointment of Special Magistrate – Administration/City Clerk**

**MOTION:** Commissioner Green moved to bring back the resolution to reappoint the current Special Magistrate and alternate. Commissioner Pulcini seconded the motion which prevailed by a unanimous roll call vote (5-0).

**Discussion and possible action on Public Safety Advisory Board status – Commission**

Commissioner Pulcini asked the City Manager if he thinks the Board is currently necessary.

Commissioner Green is in favor of allowing the board to continue, as there are residents willing to serve.

City Manager Napoli advise if there is direction for the board then it could be needed.

Mayor Ross advised there has been no direction for the board currently.

**MOTION:** Mayor Ross moved to sunset the Public Safety Advisory Board by bringing forth an Ordinance Commissioner Meltzer seconded the motion which prevailed by the following roll call vote.

**ORDINANCES ON FIRST READING**

**Ordinance 21-14 (Community Development)**

City Attorney Horowitz read “AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CITY’S CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING CHAPTER 21, ENTITLED “UNIFIED LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE;” BY SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION 21-8, ENTITLED “DEFINITIONS;” AMENDING THE DEFINITIONS OF COMMERCIAL VEHICLES AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLES; AMENDING CHAPTER 25, ENTITLED “DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS,” AMENDING ARTICLE I ENTITLED, “OFF-STREET PARKING AND LOADING,” BY SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION 25-10, ENTITLED “PARKING OF COMMERCIAL VEHICLES; RVs AND BOATS;” CLARIFYING THE PERMITTED TYPES OF TRAILERS; AUTHORIZING COMMERCIAL VEHICLES AND TRAILERS WHICH DO NOT EXCEED TEN (10) FEET IN TOTAL HEIGHT, SUBJECT TO CERTAIN CONDITIONS; INCREASING BOAT AND RV HEIGHT LIMIT TO THIRTEEN (13) FEET; ELIMINATING THE COVER REQUIREMENT FOR BOATS AND RVs; PROVIDING FOR REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS; PERMITTING THE PARKING OF BOATS AND RVs IN THE OWNER’S FRONT YARD FOR UP TO THIRTY-SIX (36) HOURS FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES; ELIMINATING THE VARIANCE FEE; PROVIDING FOR

CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE” by title.

Commissioner Shrouder moved to approve with the following recommended the following, amendments:

- Section A(1)c: Commercial vehicles or any types of trailers that do not exceed, amend to not being visible.
- Section A(1)d: and/or debris, strike the “and”.
- Section A(1)d: - move to 12 feet in height for RVs and Boats.
- Section A(1)d: RVs, Boats, or boats mounted on trailers owned by the property owner amend to include: and registered to the property.

**MOTION:** Commissioner Shrouder moved approve Ordinance 21-14 with four amendments. Commissioner Meltzer seconded the motion which prevailed by a unanimous roll call vote (5-0).

**Ordinance 21-15 (Commissioner Shrouder)**

City Attorney Horowitz read “AN ORDINANCE OF CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA; AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES, ENTITLED “ADMINISTRATION”, BY AMENDING ARTICLE IV, ENTITLED “OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES”; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION 2-102, ENTITLED “ETHICS CODE ADOPTED; APPLICABILITY; SCOPE; PENALTY;” REQUIRING ALL CITY OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES TO ACKNOWLEDGE THAT DURING THE COURSE AND SCOPE OF THEIR EMPLOYMENT WITH THE CITY THEY MAY RECEIVE CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION AND THAT THEY SHALL NOT DISCLOSE SUCH INFORMATION UNLESS REQUIRED BY LAW; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE” by title.

**MOTION:** Commissioner Meltzer moved approve Ordinance 21-15. Commissioner Pulcini seconded the motion which prevailed by a unanimous roll call vote (5-0).

**ORDINANCES ON SECOND READING (Public Hearing)**

**Ordinance 21-13 (Commissioner Shrouder)**

City Attorney Horowitz read “AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA; AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF THE COOPER CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES, ENTITLED “ADMINISTRATION”, BY AMENDING ARTICLE XI, ENTITLED “QUASI-JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS”; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION 2-273, ENTITLED “PROCEDURES FOR QUASI-JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS;” REQUIRING MEMBERS OF THE CITY COMMISSION TO DISCLOSE IF THEY RECEIVED ANY CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS FROM THE APPLICANT OR THE APPLICANT’S REPRESENTATIVES, IN A QUASI-JUDICIAL PROCEEDING; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE” by title.

Commissioner Shrouder motioned to amend to read any election cycle.

Mayor Ross said campaign reports serve as backup for years past.

Mayor Ross opened the public hearing:

David Nall, spoke on previous instances and the importance of the ordinance and disclosures.

Commissioner Shrouder advised he used to be of the opinion that you could take a contribution and still be impartial and then referenced a book about subconscious bias.

Commissioner Green supports the item and has always stated to his contributors he will do the right thing for the City the right way.

Commissioner Meltzer believes developers are expecting something in return and he implores all to stay away from those instances.

Commissioner Pulcini does not agree someone is obligated to a person that donates to your campaign.

Mayor Ross closed the public hearing.

**MOTION:** Commissioner Shrouder moved approve Ordinance 21-13. Commissioner Meltzer seconded the motion which prevailed by a unanimous roll call vote (5-0).

### **CITY MANAGER'S REPORT**

#### **Update on MPO Complete Streets Project**

City Manager Napoli spoke on bulk pickup options. Waste Management advised rates would increase for monthly or quarterly pickup with additional allowances for cubic yards. Staff is working with Waste Management for options.

Community Development Director Carlos Vega gave an update on the MPO Complete Street Project.

### **CITY ATTORNEY'S REPORT**

City Attorney Horowitz asked for a consensus on the opioid litigation settlement Memorandum of Understanding. He also advised the Florida Governor extended State of Emergency for at least 60 more. His office is following the vacation rental legislation and advised that budget amendments need posting on the city website five days after adoption.

### **POLICE CHIEF'S REPORT**

Captain De Giovanni advised traffic crashes are down 29% in Cooper City.

An operational plan has been put developed to increase traffic enforcement, as Memorial Day gets closer. During the month of May virtual learning students will be performing in-person testing which may increase morning traffic.

The commercial plaza initiative is still ongoing with all plazas being re-inspected or going through the Special Magistrate process.

The Commercial vehicle enforcement sweep will be in effect from 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm.

He thanked the residents for participating in the Ring Program.

Paws in the Park was a great event.

Lobby hours have changed to 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. seven days a week, with 24/7/365 lobby hours starting June 5, 2021.

There is currently one vacancy that will be filled in the next few weeks.

Commissioner Pulcini thanked the Captain and asked him to share good news with the City Manager for the City newsletter.

### **FIRE CHIEF'S REPORT**

Chief Bishop advised that his team has completed with their tactical surveys at Countryside Shoppes.

He has met with two candidates from Cooper City High School for the station's annual scholarship.

The next CPR class is scheduled for May 5, 2021.

Commissioner Pulcini asked how the opioid epidemic affects Cooper City. Chief Bishop advised they have tapered off but we do have them.

Mayor Ross asked if auto accidents were down due to COVID-19. Chief Bishop believes it is due to enforcement.

Commissioner Shrouder asked if there is training for firefighters on electric vehicle fires. Chief Bishop has taken the training and he is hoping to show the training to his staff soon.

Mayor Ross asked for an equipment update. Chief Bishop advised the engine was placed back into service yesterday. The 2004 aerial and the 2008 engine are still out of service.

Commissioner Shrouder asked for proposals on options.

Commissioner Pulcini thanked the men and women of BSO Fire.

#### **COMMISSIONERS' CONCERNS/REPORTS/ITEMS TO BE PLACED ON NEXT AGENDA**

Commissioner Green apologized for not being physically present.

Commissioner Pulcini thanked the residents, his colleagues and the Mayor for his lobbying.

Commissioner Meltzer thanked everyone and thanked the Mayor for his lobbying.

Commissioner Shrouder thanked Mayor Ross for his hard work lobbying.

He would like the City Attorney to revise the ordinance on transfers and bring forth an amended ordinance at the next meeting. The Commission reached consensus to direct the City Attorney to draft the ordinance for first reading.

Commissioner Shrouder would also like to bring forward a revision to the city's noise ordinance. City Attorney Horowitz will bring forward a discussion item with examples.

Commissioner Shrouder would like to schedule a community recognition meeting every quarter, as opposed to the number of proclamations and presentations that appear on the agenda regularly.

Commissioner Pulcini would like a list of what violations would necessitate a notice of violation as opposed to a citation.
