

## RESOLUTION 2023-30

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING CYBERSECURITY STANDARDS IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 282.3185(4)(A), F.S.; DELEGATING ALL CYBERSECURITY AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MANAGER, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO RESPOND TO CYBER THREATS AND TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION AS NEEDED; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; FURTHER, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City's IT Division is responsible for the City's networking infrastructure and the response to cyber-related threats; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 282.3185(4)(a), Florida Statutes, requires that each local government adopt cybersecurity standards that safeguard its data, information technology, and information technology resources to ensure availability, confidentiality, and integrity; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 119.0725(2), provides that the City's cybersecurity strategy and defense posture are exempt from public record; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager is directed to create and adopt all administrative policies related to cybersecurity and maintain adequate measures ensuring that the City's technology infrastructure is safeguarded; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission of the City of Cooper City finds this resolution to be in the best interests of the citizens and residents of the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1.** That the above “Whereas” clauses are ratified and confirmed, and they are made a part of and incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.

**Section 2.** That the City Commission delegates all cybersecurity authority and maintenance of policies to the City Manager.

**Section 3. Conflicts.** All resolutions inconsistent or in conflict herewith shall be and are hereby repealed insofar as there is conflict or inconsistency.

**Section 4. Severability.** If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this resolution.

**Section 5. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and adoption by the City Commission.
