

# CITY COMMISSION ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION

TITLE: Resolution 23-30 (Finance/IT Technology)

**DATE:** December 12, 2023

DESCRIPTION: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY,

FLORIDA, ADOPTING CYBERSECURITY STANDARDS IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 282.3185(4)(A), F.S.; DELEGATING ALL CYBERSECURITY AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MANAGER, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO RESPOND TO CYBER THREATS AND TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION AS NEEDED; PROVIDING FOR

CONFLICTS; FURTHER, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

# **CITY MANAGER RECOMMENDATION:**

The City Manager recommends approval of the adoption of cybersecurity standards, delegating all cybersecurity authority to the City Manager, and authorizing the City Manager to respond to cyber threats and take appropriate action as needed.

# **BACKGROUND OF ITEM:**

The City's IT Department is responsible for the City's networking infrastructure and cyber-related threats. Section 282.3185(4)(a), Florida Statutes, requires that each local government adopt cybersecurity standards that safeguard its data, information technology, and information technology resources to ensure availability, confidentiality, and integrity.

Section 119.0725(2), Florida Statutes, provides that the City's cybersecurity strategy and defense posture are exempt from public record. Therefore, we do not have to specify which framework the City adopts.

The City Manager is directed to create and adopt all administrative policies related to cybersecurity and maintain adequate measures to ensure the City's technology infrastructure is safeguarded. It is essential not to give potential hackers any information regarding our cybersecurity-related posture as it may provide them with the necessary information to attack and infiltrate our network infrastructure and related systems.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT:**
