TITLE: Ordinance 23-28 (Commission)

DATE: December 12, 2023

DESCRIPTION: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER

5 OF THE CITY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES, ENTITLED "ANIMALS AND FOWL;" BY SPECIFICALLY AMENDING ARTICLE I, ENTITLED "IN GENERAL," BY CREATING SECTION 5-5, TO BE ENTITLED "KEEPING OF ROOSTERS;" PROHIBITING THE KEEPING OF ROOSTERS IN RESIDENTIAL ZONING DISTRICTS IN THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. —

CITY MANAGER RECOMMENDATION:

The City Manager recommends approval of Ordinance 23-28 prohibiting the keeping of roosters in residential zoning districts in the City.

BACKGROUND OF ITEM:

At the November 14th City Commission meeting, there was a Commission discussion regarding residents who have roosters that are causing noise concerns in the neighborhoods. The Commission voted unanimously to have the City Attorney bring back an ordinance prohibiting roosters in certain areas.

ANALYSIS:

The approval of Ordinance 23-28 will prohibit the keeping of roosters and provide for enforcement in residential zoning districts in the City.
