SUBJECT: Motion to approve and authorize sole source purchase of two (2) sets of two (2) submersible pumps each and related accessories in the amount not to exceed \$57,160 from PSI Technologies Inc. for the upgrade of lift stations No. 15 and 56. - **Utilities**

CITY MANAGER RECOMMENDATION:

Motion to approve and authorize sole source purchase of two (2) sets of two (2) submersible pumps each and related accessories in the amount not to exceed \$57,160 from PSI Technologies Inc. for lift stations No. 15 and 56.

BACKGROUND OF ITEM:

The City's sewer collection/transmission system includes 82 lift stations. Although majority of these lift stations use submersible pumps, six (6) of these lift stations are "can" stations, which were common in the 1960s and 1970s. However, they are no longer desirable because of the safety and functionality reasons. As a part of the City's master plan, these "can" lift stations are being converted into lift stations that would now use submersible pumps. In FY 2023, lift station no. 15 and no. 56 are slated for conversion.

Over the last 15 years, the Utilities staff has standardized the use of Wilo pumps for majority of the City's lift stations. This has resulted in the efficiency of maintenance instead of repairing multiple brands of pumps. In South Florida, Wilo pumps are sold exclusively by PSI Technologies Inc. as the sole distributor. The Utilities staff is reporting good experience with the performance of Wilo pumps and recommends Commission approval for this sole source purchase.

In any lift station there are two (2) primary components – pumps and control panels. The upgrades to both can stations will require installation of these two components. While this authorization pertains to the sole-source purchase of Wilo pumps, a companion agenda item will request purchase of control panels, piggybacking Broward County's contract. In order to save monies, the Utilities crew will be performing majority of the work in house.
