EXPLANATION

An emergency purchase of radiator and block heater replacement for 25-year old emergency generator was authorized in the combined amount of \$47,808.68. After the equipment was disassembled, it was found that repairs and replacement of additional parts will be necessary as they had rusted and deteriorated due to age. The staff started out with changing the oil cooler, which was approved to be replaced at a cost of \$13,515.63. Since then the staff has determined that an additional expense of 8,054.00 would refurbish the generator as best as possible. Initially, the staff felt embarrassed and showed reluctance for additional expense. But it was my decision to get this work done while the opportunity is still there. This emergency generator powers both water and wastewater treatment plants during power failure and it is critical to keep the operations running. There are sufficient funds available in the Utilities Account for this new \$8,054 expense. The vendor is All Power Generators, who has served the City since 2005.

The staff is exploring grant funding to replace the generator and accessories, which are estimated to cost around \$4 million.
