Subject: Fire Chief's Report - Commission Meeting June 13, 2023




I. Fire/Rescue Incident Report

III. Community Outreach Report

- The BSO Life Safety Educators provided car seat installs for the community on May 17, 2023.
- The BSO/Cooper City EMS/Fire Scholarship was presented to two students at the Cooper City High School Awards Night. Each scholarship was worth \$2,000.00 and will be provided to the institution of choice to pay for Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) courses or to a fire academy to pay for the training to become a Florida state-certified firefighter. IV. Fire Apparatus/Station Report

- The new ladder truck is in the drawing phases.
- The new Cooper City Engine is currently at BSO Fleet Services having hose and equipment mounted on the vehicle. It is expected to be in service within a few weeks at station 28. A wet-down/push-in ceremony will take place as the vehicle becomes Cooper City's front-line Engine.
- The new Rescue truck is getting ready to paint the chassis. I will be presented with a few designs and color schemes. Production dates have not been provided by the manufacturer at this time.
