WHEREAS, the Boys and Girls Clubs of Broward County has been serving the community since 1965; and

WHEREAS, Boys & Girls Clubs are places where great futures start. They are at the forefront of efforts in teen programing, academic, character development and healthy lifestyles. Of kids enrolled 96% progressed to the next grade level, 97% of seniors graduated from high school and 76% enrolled in college; and

WHEREAS, there are 12 Boys & Girls Clubs in the County: Davie, Deerfield Beach, Pompano Beach, West Park, Hollywood, North Lauderdale, Fort Lauderdale and Lauderhill providing services to an average of 12,500 young people, ages 6-18, annually; and

WHEREAS, Boys & Girls Club organizations in our state help ensure that our young people keep off the streets offering them a safe and supportive place to go and providing them with quality programs; and

WHEREAS, Boys & Girls Clubs of Broward County will celebrate National Boys & Girls Club Week, 2021 along with some 4,000 Clubs and more than two million young people nationwide.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Commission of the City of Cooper City do hereby proclaim June 21st through June 25th, 2021 as Boys and Girls Club Week in Broward County.
