

RESOLUTION NO. 26-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, GRANTING THE REQUEST FOR VARIANCE PETITION #V11-1-25, ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT “A” AND INCORPORATED HEREIN, SUBMITTED BY ANA HARDING, FOR THE PROPERTY GENERALLY LOCATED AT 5786 SW 89th WAY, COUNTRY ADDRESS ENCORE SUBDIVISION, IN COOPER CITY, FLORIDA; GRANTING A VARIANCE FROM SECTION 25-100(d)(1)/25-5(e)(1)(c) OF THE CITY’S CODE OF ORDINANCES TO INCREASE THE PRIMARY DRIVEWAY WIDTH FROM 24-FEET TO 26-FEET AT ONE POINT AND 36-FEET AT ITS GREATEST POINT; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Ana Harding (the “Applicant”), filed an application for a variance (#V11-1-25) pursuant to Section 23-153 seeking a variance from Section 25-100(d)(1) / 25-5(E)(1)(c) of the City’s Code of Ordinances to increase the primary driveway width from 24 feet to 26 feet at one point and 36 feet at its greatest point to allow for an additional parking space on the property generally located at 5786 SW 89th Way, Country Address Encore Subdivision, in Cooper City (the “Property”); and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing on this request was held by the Planning & Zoning Board on January 6, 2026, after due notice of publication; and

WHEREAS, the Planning & Zoning Board has submitted to the City Commission their recommendation, a copy of which is included in the Staff Report attached hereto as Exhibit “B,” and recommends approval of the requested variance; and

WHEREAS, public notice was provided in accordance with law; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has reviewed the Applicant’s request and considered the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Board and finds that granting

the Applicant's request for a variance is in the best interests of the citizens and residents of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA:

Section 1: **Recitals Adopted.** That each of the above stated recitals is hereby adopted and confirmed. All exhibits to this resolution are incorporated herein and expressly made a part hereof.

Section 2: **Approval.** That the Applicant's request (#V1-1-25) is hereby approved and in accordance with Section 23-153 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Cooper City a variance is granted from Section 25-100(d)(1) / 25-5(E)(1)(c) of the City's Code of Ordinances to increase the primary driveway width from 24 feet to 26 feet at one point and 36 feet at its greatest point to allow for an additional parking space on the property generally located at 5786 SW 89th Way, Country Address Encore Subdivision, in Cooper City.

Section 3: Issuance of a development permit by a municipality does not in any way create any right on the part of an applicant to obtain a permit from a state or federal agency and does not create any liability on the part of the municipality for issuance of the permit if the applicant fails to obtain requisite approvals or fulfill the obligations imposed by a state or federal agency or undertakes actions that result in a violation of state or federal law.

Section 4. **Conflicts.** All resolutions inconsistent or in conflict herewith shall be and are hereby repealed insofar as there is conflict or inconsistency.

Section 5. **Severability.** If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this resolution.

Section 6. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and adoption by the City Commission.
