SUBJECT: Motion to approve the title transfer of the 1995 Freightliner Ambulance (VIN 1FV3GFAC2SL662754) currently used for Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) from Broward County Sheriff Department of Fire Rescue and Emergency Services to Cooper City. – **BSO Fire**

CITY MANAGER RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the transfer of title from Broward County Sheriff Department of Fire Rescue and Emergency Services (BSO-FRES) to the City of Cooper City.

BACKGROUND OF ITEM:

BSO-FRES is responding to a request to transfer title of the vehicle to the City of Cooper City.

ANALYSIS:

The City of Cooper City has a CERT program that utilized the 1995 Freightliner that was decommissioned as a frontline emergency apparatus to be used by Cooper City CERT. Due to the age of the apparatus, there was discussion to de-asset and dispose of the vehicle. According to the best recollection of BSO members familiar with the issue, Cooper City elected official(s) requested the title be transferred to Cooper City. This is the culmination of that request.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There would be no associated costs for the transfer of vehicle title other than what may be required by the State of Florida. The city would be responsible for on-going required maintenance. The league of cities has estimated the cost of insurance for the vehicle at \$900 per year.
