

RESOLUTION NO. 25-52

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURSUE AND EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (DEP) FOR THE RESILIENT FLORIDA GRANT PROGRAM; APPROVING A LOCAL MATCH REQUIREMENT EQUAL TO FIFTY PERCENT (50%) OF THE TOTAL PROJECT COST; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT THE GRANT FUNDING AND TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTION NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in 2022, the City of Cooper City received a grant in the amount of \$170,000 in accordance with the Resilient Florida Grant Program (“Grant Program”) to perform a vulnerability assessment; and

WHEREAS, the Grant Program now includes additional funding opportunities to address issues identified in the City’s vulnerability assessment; and

WHEREAS, the City’s professional staff recommending pursuing all available funding opportunities to address concerns noted in the vulnerability assessment; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission, Florida deems it to be in the best interests of the citizens and residents of the City of Cooper City to authorize the City Manager to pursue and execute a grant agreement with the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection for the Resilient Florida Grant Program, including a cost-share match equal to fifty percent (50%) of the total project costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The foregoing “WHEREAS” clause is hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and is hereby made a specific part of this Resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Cooper City, Florida hereby to authorizes the City Manager to pursue and execute a grant agreement with the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection for the Resilient Florida Grant Program. The City Commission hereby further authorizes a local match requirement for the grant in an amount equal to fifty percent (50%) of the total project cost.

Section 3. The City Manager, or City Manager's designee, is hereby authorized and directed to accept the grant funds and to take any and all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.

Section 4. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith, be and the same are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution.

Section 6. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
