

CITY COMMISSION ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION

TITLE: Resolution 21-30 (Utilities)

DESCRIPTION: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY,

FLORIDA, SUPPORTING AND APPROVING THE HIATUS ROAD ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT PLAN (THE "PROJECT"), AS MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A," ATTACHED HERETO AND INCORPORATED HEREIN; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTION NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING

FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

CITY MANAGER RECOMMENDATION:

The City Manager recommends approval of Resolution 21-30, expressing the City Commission's support and approval of this planning project for Broward County Transportation Surtax funding.

BACKGROUND OF ITEM:

Broward County and the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) have opened the application period for Cycle 2 of the Transportation Surtax Program. Staff recommends a project to study the Hiatus Road corridor, from SW 55 Street to Sheridan Street, with respect to traffic volume, safety conditions, lighting, signalization, and signage in order to produce a report recommending plans for improvements. In order to be considered for surtax funding, Broward County requires a resolution of support for this project from the City Commission.
