

CITY COMMISSION ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION

TITLE: Resolution 25-15 (Utilities)

DATE: April 8, 2025

DESCRIPTION: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY,

FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE UTILITY ACCESS AND CONSENT AGREEMENT (THE "AGREEMENT") BETWEEN THE CITY AND THE CENTRAL BROWARD WATER CONTROL DISTRICT (THE "DISTRICT"), ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT "A;" AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT FOR FUTURE LOCATIONS AND FUTURE UTILITY INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS IN AND OUTSIDE THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE

DATE.

CITY MANAGER RECOMMENDATION:

The City Manager recommends approval of the Utility Access and Consent Agreement with The Central Broward Water Control District for future Utility infrastructure projects in and outside the City.

BACKGROUND OF ITEM:

The Central Broward Water Control District criteria require Municipalities to enter into a UACA agreement to place Utilities within their existing drainage easements. The Central Broward Water Control District, through the passage of Resolution No. 25-15 grants the City of Cooper City, their contractors, and developers the right to install utility infrastructure within their drainage easements.

ANALYSIS:

Without this District & City UACA agreement, the City would not have the possibility to extend utility infrastructure into the Southwest Ranches and Town of Davie communities. The Cooper City Treatment Plant system has sufficient capacity to support this request.
