



## CITY COMMISSION ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION

**TITLE:** Resolution 23-15 (Administration)

**DESCRIPTION:** A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING HONORARILY DESIGNATING THE PORTION OF S.R. 823/ SOUTH FLAMINGO ROAD BETWEEN SOUTHWEST 52<sup>ND</sup> STREET AND SOUTHWEST 55<sup>TH</sup> STREET IN BROWARD COUNTY AS ARCHBISHOP EDWARD A. MCCARTHY HIGH SCHOOL WAY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. – **Commissioner Green**

**CITY MANAGER RECOMMENDATION:**

The City Manager recommends approval of Resolution 23-15 designating the portion of S.R. 823/ South Flamingo Road between Southwest 52<sup>nd</sup> Street and Southwest 55<sup>th</sup> Street as Archbishop Edward A. McCarthy High School Way.

**BACKGROUND OF ITEM:**

The Florida State Legislature and the Governor approved a road designation during the most recent Legislative Session as follows:

“The portion of S.R. 823/South Flamingo Road between Southwest 52<sup>nd</sup> Street and Southwest 55<sup>th</sup> Street in Broward County is designated as “Archbishop Edward A. McCarthy High School Way.”

Although Archbishop McCarthy High School is located in the Town of Southwest Ranches, this portion of Flamingo Road also falls within Cooper City. Florida Statute 334.071 indicates that if the road segment being designated is located in more than one city, resolutions supporting the designation must be passed by each affected local government prior to the erection of the markers.

**ANALYSIS:**

The school is hoping to have the sign installed in time for the first day of school in mid-August, but FDOT will not be able to install until they receive resolutions from Southwest Ranches and Cooper City.
