



CITY COMMISSION ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION

TITLE: Resolution 24-32 (Finance)

DATE: September 24, 2024

DESCRIPTION: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY ADOPTING A TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATE OF 5.865 FOR GENERAL OPERATING BUDGET PURPOSES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025; PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AND SETTING FORTH THE DATE, TIME AND LOCATION OF THE PUBLIC HEARING TO FORMALLY ADOPT THE FY 2024-2025 MILLAGE RATE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

CITY MANAGER RECOMMENDATION:

The City Manager recommends the approval of Resolution 24-32, setting the proposed operating millage rate for FY 25 at 5.865. According to the Florida TRIM bill, the millage rate must be discussed and adopted before the annual budget is adopted.

BACKGROUND OF ITEM:

At the July 23, 2024, meeting, the Commission passed Resolution 24-21, a Proposed Operating Millage rate of 5.865. This is an increase of 7.34% over the rolled-back rate of 5.4637 mils.

ANALYSIS:

Staff recommends setting the maximum ad valorem operating millage rate of 5.865 mils, with no change in the operating millage from the prior year. This proposed millage rate represents an increase of 7.34% over the rolled-back millage rate of 5.4637.
