TITLE: Resolution 21-57 (City Clerk)

DESCRIPTION: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF COOPER CITY AND THE SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS OF BROWARD COUNTY FOR MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS, ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT “A,” AND INCORPORATED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR EXECUTION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

CITY MANAGER RECOMMENDATION:

The City Manager recommends approval of Resolution 21-57 and the agreement between the City and the Supervisor of Elections of Broward County.

BACKGROUND OF ITEM:

The Supervisor of Elections of Broward County conducts the municipal elections for the City.

ANALYSIS:

The Supervisor of Elections of Broward County has requested that all municipalities utilizing the SOE to conduct their elections enter into a new agreement outlining the services they will perform and the City’s responsibilities.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Final elections costs will be based on a number of factors including number of ballot styles, charter questions, and number of poll workers assigned. An estimate for the November election has been provided by the SOE and is included as Exhibit A. This will be budgeted in FY23.
