SUBJECT: Motion to approve agreement with Weekly Asphalt, Inc. on second renewal -
Public Works

CITY MANAGER RECOMMENDATION:

The City Manager recommends approval of an agreement with Weekly Asphalt, Inc. on second renewal.

BACKGROUND OF ITEM:

In 2019, the City bid out asphalt resurfacing. Upon completion of the bid process, the bids came in 20% higher than an already established contract through Broward County. At the July 19, 2019 Commission meeting, Commission gave direction to reject the bids due to the increased costs. Staff then presented and the Commission approved the piggyback option based off of Broward County contract #PNC2118215B1. This leverages the purchasing power of the County to reduce costs for the City.

ANALYSIS:

This is a recommendation and request for approval to the second renewal agreement out of two renewal agreements with Weekly Asphalt, Inc. to piggyback off the Broward County Contract #PNC21182215B1.

FISCAL IMPACT:

At the September 23, 2021 meeting, the Commission approved the FY2022 budget with an appropriation of \$574,331.00 for asphalt paving, root pruning, and guardrail repairs. In account 103-313-534710-541 there is \$514,331.00 for asphalt paving, \$40,000 for root pruning, and \$20,000 for guardrail repairs.
