Rescue 28 Update:

On Wednesday, January 29th BSO Fleet Manager, Victor Goizueta, was able to sign-off and approve the final rescue specification drawings provided by the contracted manufacturer. We were recently informed that REV anticipates having the final inspection late March or early April 2025.

- Fire Station 28's communications ability was upgraded with the installation of a Cellular BDA which increases the connectivity of wireless devices, such as the mobile data terminals, laptops and tablets.

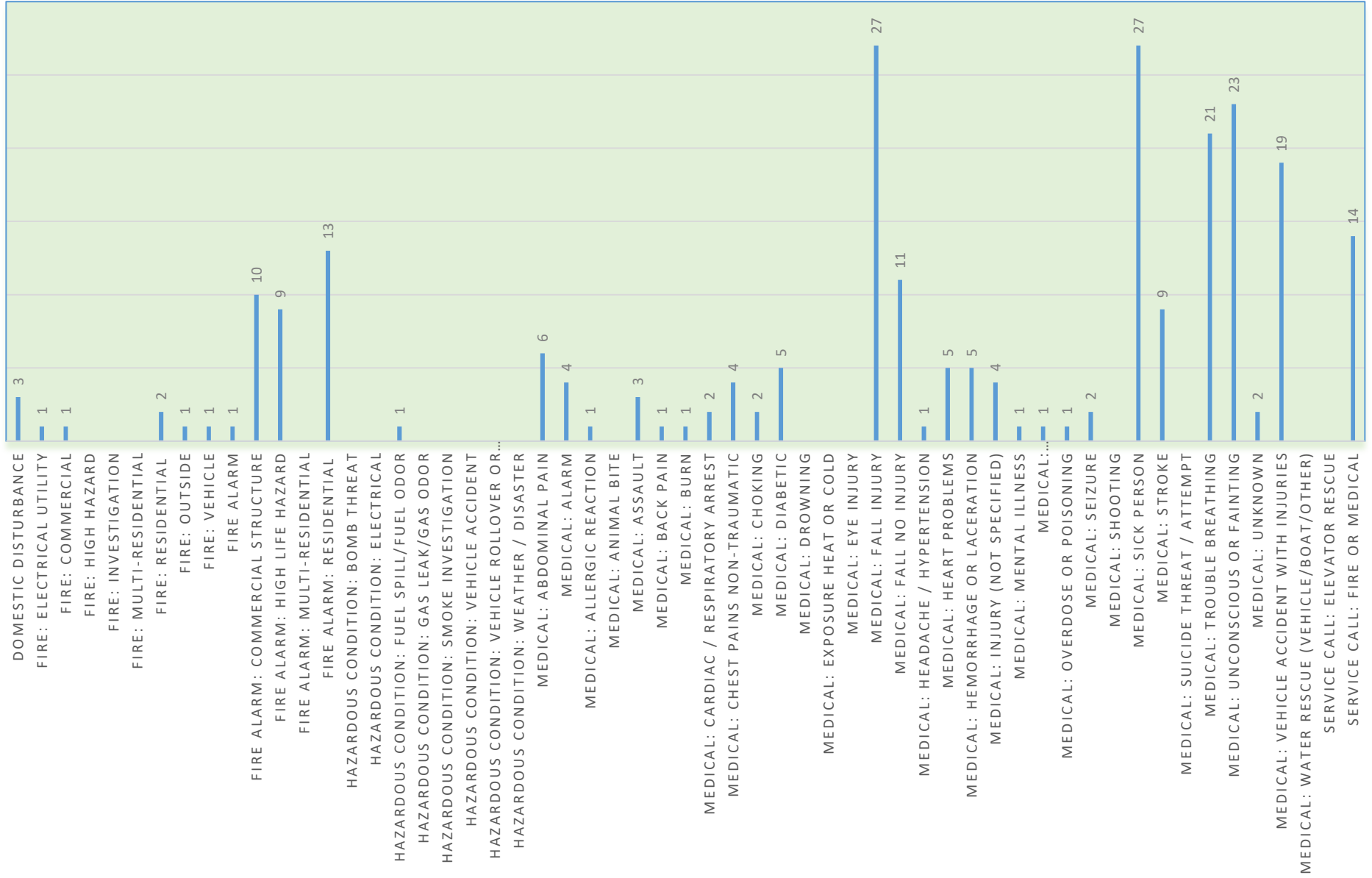

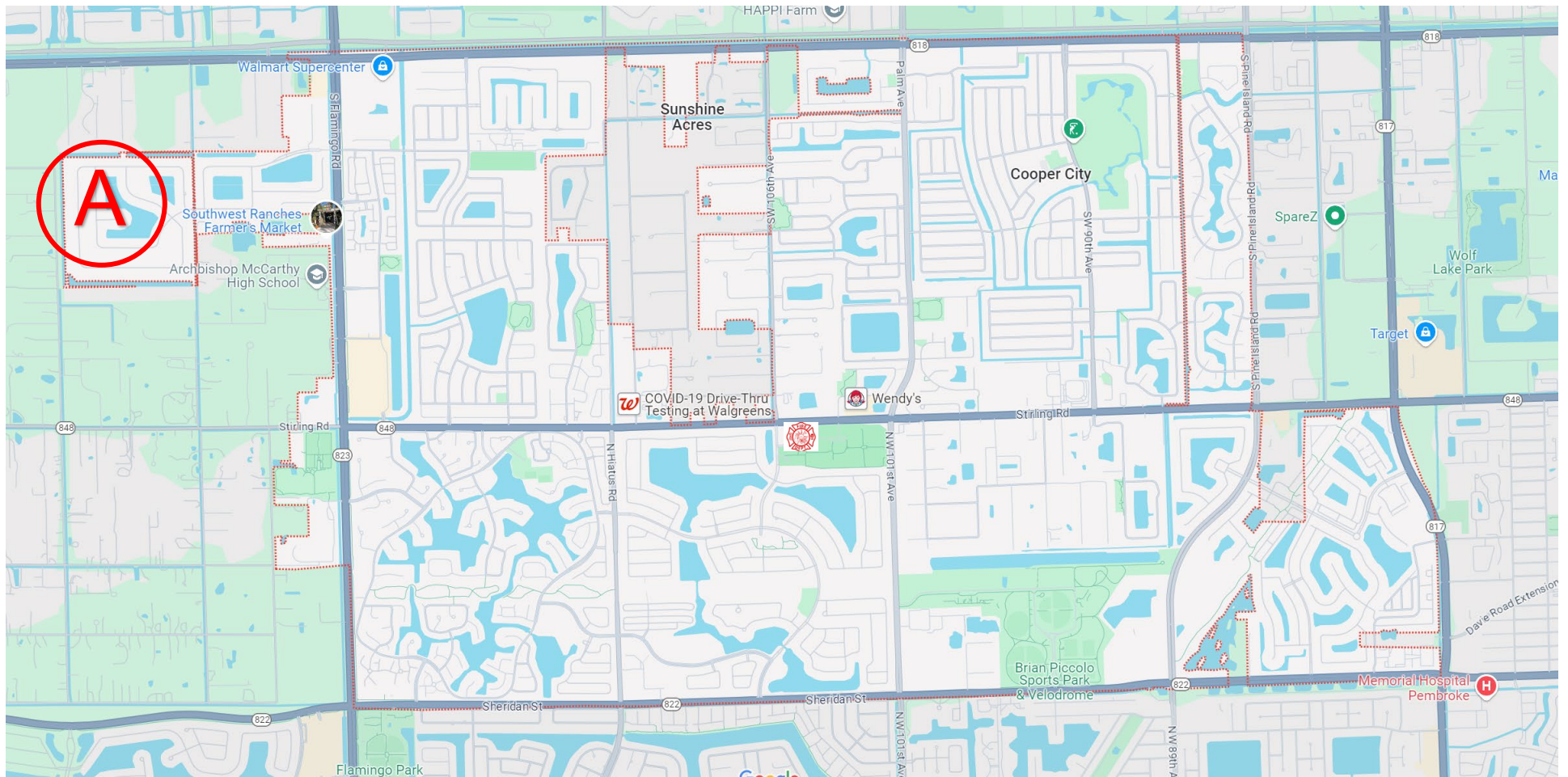
V. COMMUNITY OUTREACH REPORT
