The following Special Terms and Conditions have been agreed upon by and between the CITY and BSO:

EFFECTIVE DATE:	October 1, 2020

TERM:	October 1, 2020 – September 30, 2025
RENEWAL OPTION:	Renewable for two (2), five (5) year terms upon the City and BSO agreeing to such renewal and the terms and conditions thereto.

MINIMUM STAFFING:	Utilizing the staffing structure as set forth above, the District Captain shall provide the CITY with a minimum of one sergeant and six uniformed deputy sheriffs on duty at all times in the District, in a Patrol Unit or Patrol Unit equipped with a bicycle for purposes of patrol. The District Captain has the ability to deploy the deputies as needed for the benefit of the District.
SHIFT SCHEDULE	District deputies currently work a twelve hour shift. The length of shift may be altered upon mutual agreement of the Sheriff and City Manager.

Specific Terms:	<p><u>Criminal Investigations Unit</u></p> <p>A Criminal Investigations Unit shall be maintained to conduct the necessary investigations of criminal activity within the CITY. The District Criminal Investigations Unit is a specialized assignment within the CITY for particular investigations where and as the need for same requires.</p>

The Unit shall not operate in the traditional shift structure. The Criminal Investigations Unit shall be comprised of four detectives, one sergeant and one Crime Analyst/ Investigative Aide II from the staffing structure described above. One of the four detectives shall be assigned to oversee and maintain the city's technology equipment, such as: ALPRS, Portable / Fixed cameras, trailers, platforms, and serve as a RTCC liaison. The deputies assigned to this Unit shall handle criminal investigations not handled by the central Criminal Investigations Division.

Crime Suppression / Tactical Deployment Team

A Crime Suppression Team (CST) shall be operated to conduct the necessary investigations of criminal activity within the CITY. The District Crime Suppression Team is a specialized assignment within the CITY designed to target quality-of-life crime issues, such as residential and conveyance burglaries, robberies, and narcotics enforcement etc. The CST shall be comprised of two (2) deputy sheriffs from the staffing structure described above. The Unit shall not operate in the traditional shift structure but shall generally provide coverage on a flexible schedule, the on-duty status and deployment of the team shall be determined by the District Captain or designee.

Lobby Coverage

The SHERIFF shall staff the Cooper City Police station lobby 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

K-9 and Field Training Deputies

Two (2) of the Uniformed Deputy Sheriffs from the staffing structure set forth above shall be canine handlers. The Cooper City District should be included in the SHERIFF's list of "training districts" and utilized for same when needed.

Crime Prevention Programs

The SHERIFF shall offer crime prevention and related

	<p>programs, through Personnel assigned to the CITY that are mutually beneficial and mutually agreeable to the CITY and SHERIFF.</p> <p><u>SRO / Renaissance Charter School</u></p> <p>One of the school resources officers included in the CITY's law enforcement complement shall be assigned to the Renaissance Charter School ("Renaissance"), and the cost of this position shall be reimbursed to the CITY, in full, by Renaissance pursuant to a separate, tri-party agreement between the CITY, BSO and Renaissance.</p>
