

RESOLUTION NO. 26-27

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURSUE THE BROWARD METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION (MPO) TRANSPORTATION MASTER PLAN (TMP) PROGRAM GRANT; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SCOPE OF WORK TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE AGREEMENT FOR THE MPO TMP PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY AMENDMENTS TO THE AGREEMENT, ACCEPT TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE SERVICES, AND TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTION NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization City Services Team offers in-kind technical assistance grants to member governments to develop Transportation Master Plans; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Master Plan aims to enhance safety, improve multimodal connectivity, and align transportation infrastructure with the City's future land use goals; and

WHEREAS, the scope of the City's anticipated Transportation Master Plan is detailed on the Staff Report, which is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems it to be in the best interests of the citizens and residents of the City to authorize the City Manager to pursue and execute a grant agreement with the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization to prepare a Transportation Master Plan in the amount of \$175,000, including a ten percent (10%) City contribution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The foregoing “WHEREAS” clause is hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and is hereby made a specific part of this Resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Cooper City, Florida hereby authorizes the City Manager to pursue and execute a grant agreement with Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Transportation Master Plan Program Grant. The Mayor and the City Manager are authorized to execute the interlocal agreement and any necessary grant documents, including the scope of work technical assistance agreement for the MPO TMP Program and any necessary amendments.

Section 3. The City Manager, or City Manager’s designee, is hereby authorized and directed to accept the grant funds and to take any and all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.

Section 4. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith, be and the same are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution.

Section 6. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
