TITLE: Resolution 22-35 (Finance)

DESCRIPTION: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO THE

PROVISION OF FIRE SERVICES, FACILITIES AND PROGRAMS IN THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA; ESTABLISHING THE RATE OF ASSESSMENT; IMPOSING FIRE ASSESSMENTS AGAINST ASSESSED PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY OF COOPER CITY; APPROVING THE ASSESSMENT ROLL; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE

DATE.

CITY MANAGER RECOMMENDATION:

The City Manager recommends approval of Resolution No. 22-35, adopting the final fire assessment rate at 81% of fire costs.

BACKGROUND OF ITEM:

On July 26, 2022, the City Commission adopted Resolution 22-29, which preliminary approved the fire assessment rate at 81% of fire costs. See chart below for rate comparison

ANALYSIS:

The estimated fire assessed cost is approximately \$4,620,971.56. The total amount of Fire Assessment budgeted in the fiscal year 2022-23 proposed budget is \$4,436,171.
