**RESOLUTION NO. 20-4-1**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, RENEWING AND EXTENDING THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE LIST OF CHARITIES AND FUNDRAISING EVENTS FORMALLY APPROVED BY THE CITY OF COOPER CITY AS AUTHORIZED BY THE BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF ETHICS FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS; PROVIDING FOR RESTRICTIONS; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission of the City of Cooper City adopted a list of City sponsored charities and fundraising events via Resolution No. 11-12-6 on December 13, 2011, and subsequently renewed and extended the list pursuant to Resolution No. 13-1-2, Resolution No. 15-1-5, Resolution 16-1-7, Resolution 17-1-5, Resolution 18-1-2 and Resolution 19-9-2; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission desires to further renew and extend the effectiveness of the list, and of the formal approval of the charities and fundraising events, which are listed on Exhibit “A”, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.     Recitals Adopted.** That the recitals stated above are hereby adopted and confirmed.

**Section2.     List of Charities and Fundraising Events;**

- A.           That the City Commission hereby renews and extends the formal approval of each of the charities and fundraising events that are set forth on Exhibit “A” (the “Formally Approved Charities and Events”) from April 29, 2020 to December 2020 unless otherwise amended.

B. That inclusion as a Formally Approved Charity or Event shall expire at the conclusion of a one (1) year period from the date of City Commission approval, unless the City approval is renewed, extended or earlier terminated by motion adopted by the City Commission.

**Section 3. Prior Resolution.** That except as otherwise provided above, Resolution No. 11-12-6, shall remain in full force and effect, and shall be construed to conform to the changes in terminology concerning charitable contribution fundraising as provided by County Code Section 1-19 (C)(5)(a)(4) as amended by County Ordinance No. 2015-55, which revised the term “ sponsored” to “ formally approved” .

**Section 4. Effective Date.** That this Resolution shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption, and shall be effective from April 29, 2020 to December 2020.
