As you are aware, we recently updated our club's insurance policies to include new requirements outlined by the FUA,

Our prior policies cost approximately \$55,000. The updated policies are estimated at \$65,500, with the \$10,500 increase driven primarily by the coverages required under the FUA.

The club would like to respectfully request the City's assistance in offsetting this increase by contributing the \$10,500 difference in premium costs.

As you know, the club has absorbed rising expenses related to background checks and general operating costs over the past one to two years. You may also recall that the club previously received an annual contribution of \$30,000 from the City to help offset operating expenses. This support ended several years ago, resulting in all cost increases being passed directly on to our participants.

We would greatly appreciate the City's support and partnership on this matter.
