Sec. 19-142. Extensions outside municipal boundaries.

- (a) Owners, builders or developers being potential consumers of the City's water and/or wastewater service, wherein the subject property lies outside the municipal boundaries of the City, may apply to the City for the extension of water distribution and sewage collection mains to said property.
- (b) The City shall not extend water distribution and/or sewage collection services outside of the limits of the municipal boundaries, unless the subject property is located within the City's service area and the distribution and/or collection is approved by the City Commission.
- (c) For any properties not located within the City's corporate limits which receive water distribution and/or sewage collection services from the City, the City shall institute a surcharge of 25 percent upon all charges, or such other amount as authorized by general or special law and Section 19-101 of this Code, as may be amended from time to time. Any surcharge or other charges imposed consistent with this section shall continue to apply to any properties not within the City's corporate limits which were connected to the City's utility system prior to September 13, 2006.
