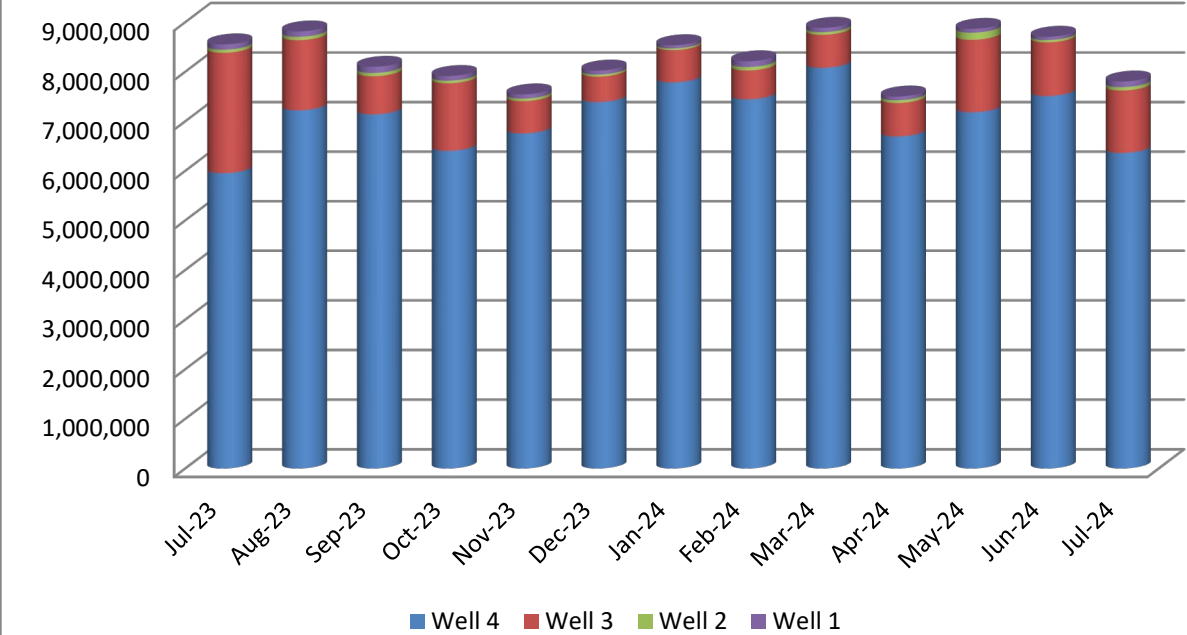
WASTEWATER
