STREETS, PROPERTIES, AND STORM SEWER

- Completed pothole patching.
- Dragged baseball field at Suppeland Park.
- Added 15 tons of ag-lime, dragged, and installed new home plate at CCP.
- Removed snowfence and curb markers from snow operations.
- Take electronics to recycling event.
- Repaired ADA ramp at Somonauk & Benson.
- Repaired 3 storm sewer structures.
- Completed street sweeping on all Town streets.
- Switched holiday banners to spring/summer banners.



- Repaired 6 areators in Cell 1.




