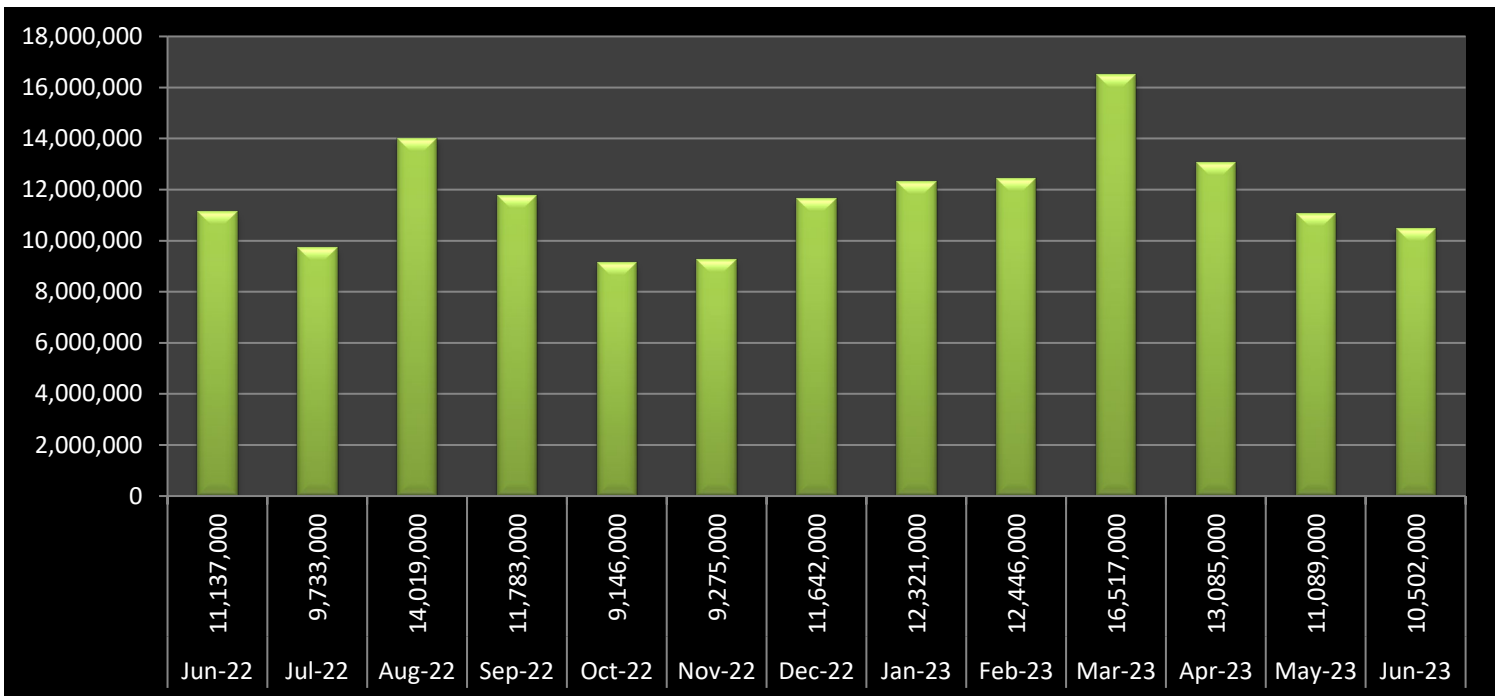

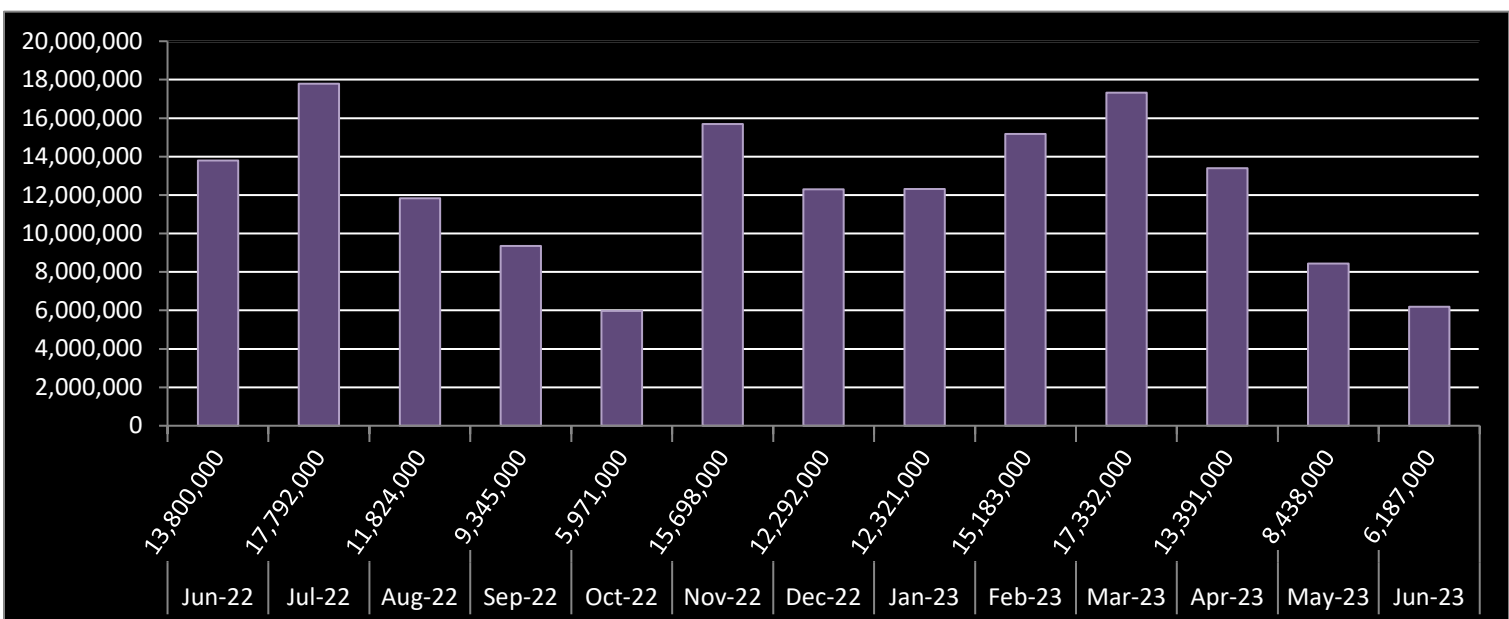
WASTEWATER

INFLUENT

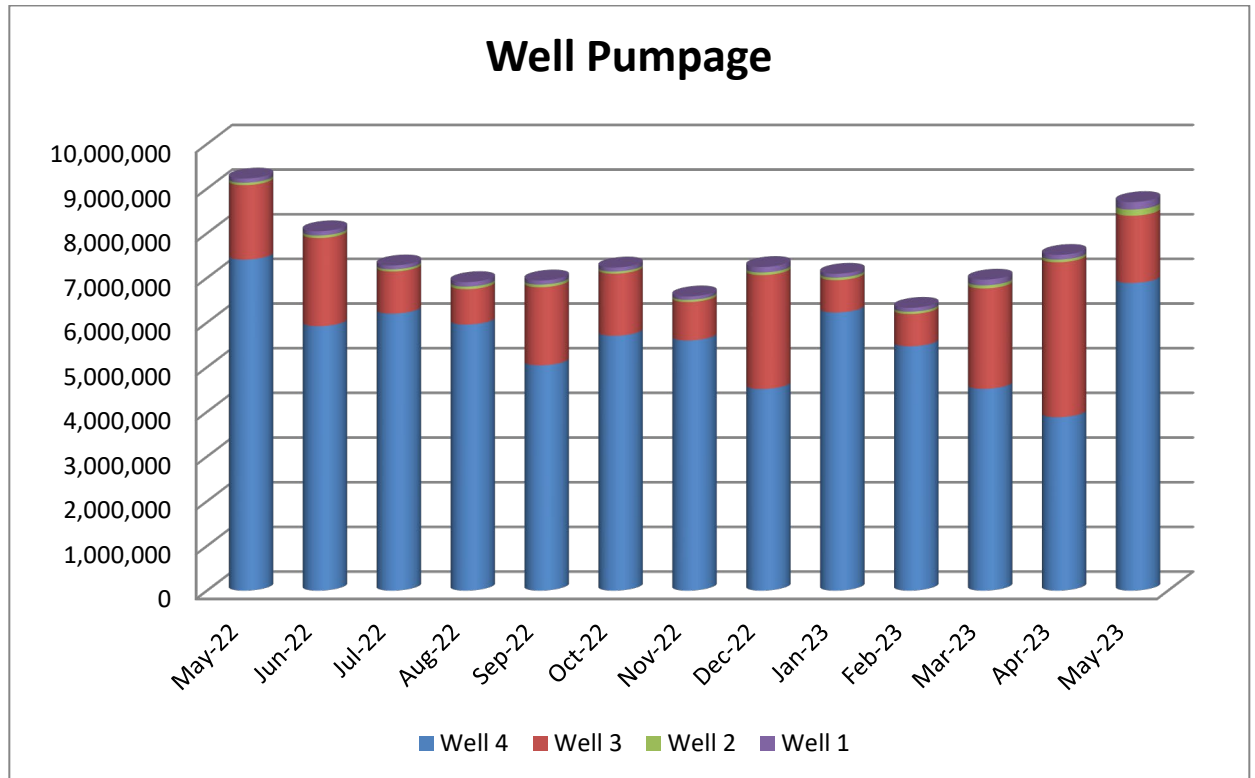


EFFLUENT
