### ANNUAL TAX LEVY ORDINANCE

**ORDINANCE NO. 2022-\_\_\_\_** 

An Ordinance levying taxes for all corporate purposes for the Town of Cortland and for the Cortland Community Library, DeKalb County, Illinois, for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2023, and ending April 30, 2024.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CORTLAND, DEKALB COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION ONE. That the amounts hereinafter set forth, or so much thereof as may be authorized by law, and the same are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the municipality as that property is assessed and equalized for the current year, and for such purposes as: general corporate purposes and maintenance of a public library for the fiscal year of the said TOWN OF CORTLAND, DeKalb County, Illinois, and the said CORTLAND COMMUNITY LIBRARY, DeKalb County, Illinois, beginning May 1, 2023, and ending April 30, 2024.

SECTION TWO. That the amount levied for each object and purpose is placed in a separate column under the heading "Amounts to be Raised by Tax Levy," which appears over same being as follows, to wit:
