


## **WASTEWATER**

- Total raw wastewater flow into the plant (Influent) 8,167,000
- Total treated wastewater from the plant: (Effluent)
- · Completed normal sewer main jetting.
- Continued to build/repair aerators at the STP.
- Continued to explore phosphate mitigation treatments.
- Took the electric motor from turbo blower #1 to a shop for repairs.
- Re-attached 18 aerators in the lagoons at the STP.
- Completed the permit application for treated wastewater discharge.

## **INFLUENT**


