Listed below is a summary of the activities of the Public Works Department for November

STREETS, PROPERTIES, AND STORM SEWER

- Patched potholes as needed.
- Removed radar speed signs for the PD.
- Removed Spring/Summer light pole banners.
- Installed holiday lights on streetlights.
- Install the 1st annual Candy Cane Lane display.
- Assisted Dekalb County Highway Department with the ped path extension.
- 440 yards of leaves were collected this fall.
- Took delivery of 350 tons of road salt.
- Continued to grind sidewalks.




WASTEWATER

- Total raw wastewater flow into the plant (Influent) 7,934,000
- Total treated wastewater from the plant: (Effluent) 16,227,000
- Completed monthly wastewater sampling.
- Completed normal sewer main jetting.
- Took delivery of re-built STP pump.
- Surface inspected the wastewater force main from the STP to Barber Green lift station.
- Replaced 2 SCADA radios at lift stations because they were outdated and malfunctioning.

INFLUENT




EFFLUENT



WATER

- Completed daily lab samples related to water quality. (pH, Fluoride, Chlorine, Hardness)
- Monthly chemical injection reports were complete and mailed to the IEPA.
- Completed monthly sampling.
