- IV. COMMENTS MUST BE ADDRESSED TO MAYOR AS THE PRESIDING OFFICER OF THE MEETING
- V. COMMENTS MUST BE PRESENTED IN A RESPECTFUL AND NONDISRUPTIVE MANNER
- VI. REPETITIVE COMMENTS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED
