Re: Jasmine Creek Maintenance SSA


Running underneath Jasmine Drive from Gaylord Road to the west city limits, the area commonly known as Jasmine Creek represents an oasis of maintenance uncertainty. County documents list Canterbury Homes, a defunct developer as the owner of record as they never transferred ownership to a home owner's association (HOA). Maintenance is severely lacking, and the resulting weeds, reeds, and trees affect the flow of storm water through the area. Additionally, the channel's inability to convey storm water effectively results in some localized flooding onto certain neighboring properties.

Responding to a request to address maintenance concerns within the area, staff solicited an informational quote for initial maintenance to remove the causal material as well as a price for ongoing maintenance. As both represented substantial cost and given the fact that the property in question does not fall under public ownership, staff began the process of determining the steps necessary, and parameters involved in establishing a Special Service Assessment (SSA) for the area in cooperation with Dana Ludwig of Robinson Engineering and Chris Spesia of Spesia & Taylor.

Under an SSA, properties reasonably considered to contribute storm water to the creek would pay an assessment to the City based on actual maintenance costs for that year. The City would administer a maintenance program through a contractor on behalf of the HOAs to provide service to the area. Conversations between the three parties mentioned led to an agreement on the most logical area of assessment based on several factors. Both Ms. Ludwig and Mr. Spesia will attend the Work Session on October 28 to further discuss the affected area and process of establishing the SSA.

Various cost estimates, impact to property owners, and maps of the proposed SSA are included at the end of this memorandum for your information.

Staff seeks Council direction whether to proceed with initiating the formal process of establishing an SSA for this area.
