A RESOLUTION APPROVING A PURCHASE ORDER BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF CREST HILL, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AND YOUR-TYPE 3D EVENT LETTERS FOR THE PURCHASE OF THREE (3) CUSTOM CREST HILL HISTORIC ROUTE 66 SIGNS

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the City of Crest Hill, Will County, Illinois, have the authority to adopt resolutions and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to the City’s government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-2-12 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/2-2-12), the City Council possesses the authority to enter into contracts that serve the legitimate corporate purposes of the City; and

WHEREAS, the year 2026 marks the Historic Route 66 Centennial; and

WHEREAS, the Heritage Corridor Convention and Visitors Bureau (“CVB”) is an Illinois Not-For-Profit Corporation that partners with communities to promote the historic I&M Canal National Heritage Area; and

WHEREAS, in 2023, the City of Crest Hill partnered with CVB to bring an interactive Route 66 Monument (“MONUMENT”) to the City of Crest Hill to commemorate the 100th Anniversary of Route 66; and

WHEREAS, the national launch of the Historic Route 66 Centennial celebration is planned in Springfield, Missouri, on April 30, 2026, with multiple other events and celebrations planned within Illinois, the Heritage Corridor, and the Chicagoland area throughout the year; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is in the City’s best interests to participate in the Centennial celebration commemorating the naming of Historic Route 66 by purchasing additional 3D signs to be placed along the Route 66 corridor in Crest Hill; and

WHEREAS, Your-Type.com (the “Company”), is a company that creates custom designed 3D signs such as the one which is already on display at the Crest Hill City Hall building; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to engage the Company to manufacture the three 3D Route 66 Commemorative signs for the City; and

WHEREAS, City Staff has received a Purchase Order Estimate dated February 24, 2026, in the total amount of \$38,820.00 for the manufacture of the three (3) 3D signs, plus delivery to the City (the “Agreement”). A copy of the Purchase Order Estimate is attached hereto as Exhibit A and fully incorporated herein); and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the Purchase Order Estimate and determined that the conditions, terms, and provisions of the Agreement are fair, reasonable, and acceptable to the City and should be approved in a not to exceed amount of \$38,820.00; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the City and its citizens to authorize the Purchase Order with the Company.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Crest Hill, Illinois, pursuant to its statutory authority, as follows:

SECTION 1: PREAMBLE. The City Council hereby finds that all the recitals contained in the preamble to this Resolution are true, correct, and complete and are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2: PURCHASE ORDER ESTIMATE APPROVED. The City Council hereby finds and declares that the conditions, terms, and provisions of the Purchase Order Estimate in a not to exceed amount of \$38,820.00 (Exhibit A) are fair, reasonable, and acceptable to the City and that the same is hereby approved in form and substance. Therefore, the City Council hereby authorizes and directs the Mayor to execute and deliver, and the Clerk to attest, the Purchase Order Estimate and further to take any and all other actions, including without limitation the execution and delivery of any and all documents, necessary and appropriate to effectuate the intent of this Resolution, which is to enter into the Agreement with the Company.

SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Resolution is held invalid, the invalidity of such section, paragraph, clause, or provision shall not affect any other provision of this Resolution.

SECTION 4: REPEALER. All ordinances, resolutions or orders, or parts thereof, which conflict with the provisions of this Resolution, are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval, as provided by law.
