Recommended Council Action:

Approve an ordinance declaring certain personal property owned by the City of Crest Hill to be surplus and authorize its disposal through public auction or scrap recycling, as applicable.

Funding Impact:

If the surplus property is sold, the City will receive revenue from the auction. The total amount of revenue is unknown and will vary depending on the final auction results. Miscellaneous metals and motors taken to the scrap yard will also generate scrap-metal proceeds. All revenue from both the surplus auction and scrap recycling will be deposited into the Vehicle Replacement Fund, 11-00-7301.
