**Summary:** As the City prepares to apply for the OSLAD grant, the City needs to have a name for the project. A name is also needed for the letters of support that we will be seeking as soon as this week.

Internally, we have come up with calling the area the Crest Hill Commons. The reason why this name is currently being used is because this placemaking space is to be used for various events, it's more than a park, and it will hopefully become the City's central gathering/meeting space. The name is also essential information to include in letters of support from our State Representatives and Senators, as well as from the Park, Library, Fire, and School districts.

At the July 27, 2026 Work Session, staff sought comments and guidance from City Council and as a majority, expressed support for the name "Crest Hill Commons". With approval, the City will use the name to refer to the proposed project and start to request letters of support.
