Agenda Item:	A Resolution Approving a customer work agreement by and between the City of Crest Hill and the State of Illinois Capital Development Board for the design and construction of a new water main extension from well number 11 East along Division Street to the Illinois State Police District 5 Headquarters and the new Illinois State Police Crime Lab.

Summary: This agreement has been reviewed and vetted by City staff and the City Attorney and the State of Illinois through the Capital Development Board. This agreement will reimburse the City for all costs associated with the preparation of the design, survey, conveyance documents, and construction, construction engineering and testing required for a water main extension along the south side of Division in an utility easement provided by the Department of Corrections for the new Crime Lab and existing State Police District 5 building.

Once the project is completed the City of Crest Hill will be have ownership of this new water main.

The work is currently estimated to be approximately 1.8 million dollars and is to be completed prior to the construction of the new State Crime Lab facility.
