- Applied for a \$50,000.00 grant to pay for professional services and unknown service investigation.
- Completed additional research on city existing material types and reduce number of unknowns to 1415.
  - 1397 Public and 118 private.

#### **Next Steps**

- Determine unknown Material by:
  - Residential surveys & Public Outreach.
  - Metal detectors & Exploratory Excavation.
- Goal to complete inventory by end of 2026.
- Work to be partially paid for through LSLI grant program at maximum grant amount of \$50,000.00 per year.
  - 25, 26, 27 = \$150k being sought.
- Once unknowns are reduced as much as possible required letters to residents & business to be sent out. Estimated Date Mid August.
