A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING THROUGH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FIRE, AMBULANCE, AND SERVICE TRUCK (FAST) PROGRAM

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CROCKETT, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOR THE FIRE, AMBULANCE, AND SERVICE TRUCK (FAST) GRANT PROGRAM; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ACT AS THE CITY'S AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVEOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Crockett desires to develop a viable community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low-to-moderate income; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of the City of Crockett to apply for funding under the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CROCKETT, TEXAS:

- 1. That a Texas Community Development Block Grant Program application for the Fire, Ambulance, and Service Truck (FAST) Program Fund is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the City with the Texas Department of Agriculture.
- 2. That the City's application be placed in competition for funding under the Downtown Revitalization Program Fund.
- 3. That the application be for \$750,000.00 of grant funds toward the purchase of a new fire truck to replace an old fire truck and administration for the grant.
- 4. That the City Council directs and designates the following to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City's participation in the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program:
 - The Mayor and City Administrator shall serve as the City's Chief Executive Officers and Authorized Representatives to execute this application and any subsequent contractual documents;
 - The Mayor and City Administrator are authorized to execute the environmental review documents between the Texas Department of Agriculture and the City; and
 - If the application is funded, the Mayor, City Administrator, and City Secretary are authorized to execute the Request for Payment Form documents and/or other forms required for requesting funds to reimburse project costs.
- 5. That all funds will be used in accordance with all applicable federal, state, local and programmatic requirements including but not limited to procurement, environmental review, labor standards, real property acquisition, and civil rights requirements.
