

MINUTES OF THE CROCKETT CITY COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON THE 20th DAY OF APRIL 2026 IN THE CITY HALL COUNCIL CHAMBERS, LOCATED AT 200 NORTH FIFTH IN THE CITY OF CROCKETT, HOUSTON COUNTY TEXAS AT 6:00 P.M.

THE COUNCIL MET IN REGULAR SESSION WITH THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS PRESENT: IANTHIA FISHER, DENNIS IVEY, NATRENIA HICKS, ELBERT JOHNSON & MIKE MARSH. Mayor Pro Tem Marsh made a motion to approve the minutes as written. Council member Johnson seconded the motion. Motion passes 4-0.

4. CONSIDER AND APPROVE A CARNIVAL/CIRCUS PERMIT APPLICATION FROM MAGIC DREAMS ENTERTAINMENT, LLC TO BE HELD ON APRIL 21-26, 2026, AT THE CROCKETT CIVIC CENTER

Mayor Pro Tem Marsh made a motion to approve a Carnival/Circus permit application from Magic Dreams Entertainment, LLC to be held on April 21-26, 2026, at the Crockett Civic Center. Council member Ivey seconded the motion. Motion passes 4-0.

5. CONSIDER AND APPROVE A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF CROCKETT, TEXAS AUTHORIZING CITY REPRESENTATIVES IN MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM.

Council member Hicks made a motion to approve a resolution of the City Council of Crockett, Texas, but not authorizing the City Administrator, Mayor or City Secretary to make executive decisions and requiring the city council to make those decisions. Motion dies for lack of a second. Mayor Pro Tem Marsh made a motion to approve a Resolution of the City Council of Crockett, Texas authorizing city representatives to in matters pertaining to the City's participation in the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program. Council member Johnson seconded the motion. Motion passes 4-0.
