

MINUTES OF THE CROCKETT CITY COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON THE 1st DAY OF MAY 2026 IN THE CITY HALL COUNCIL CHAMBERS, LOCATED AT 200 NORTH FIFTH IN THE CITY OF CROCKETT, HOUSTON COUNTY TEXAS AT 12:00 P.M.

THE COUNCIL MET IN SPECIAL SESSION WITH THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS PRESENT: IANTHIA FISHER, DENNIS IVEY, CHRISTOPHER PRICE, & MIKE MARSH. CITY OFFICIALS PRESENT: CITY ADMINISTRATOR JOHN ANGERSTEIN AND PROGRAM MANAGER BUTCH CALVERT. NATRENIA HICKS AND ELBERT JOHNSON WERE ABSENT.

OPEN MEETING WITH INVOCATION AND PLEDGE

Mayor Fisher called the formal session open and council member Ivey gave the invocation. All joined in reciting the pledge.

BUSINESS

1. CONSIDER AND APPROVE NEW STREET NAME

Mr. Angerstein explained that the Crockett Lions Club had reached out to the city about naming the access road next to the Porth Ag Arena in honor of James Waldrop to recognize of his years of service to the City of Crockett, the State of Texas and the United States. Mr. Waldrop was instrumental in developing the Porth Ag Arena in its past and current forms and was very active in the agriculture community. Mr. Stephen Wells of the Crockett Lions Club spoke in support of the issue and asked the council to approve the name change. Mayor Pro Tem Marsh made a motion to name the access road “James Waldrop Service Road.” Council member Price seconded the motion. Motion passes 3-0.

Council member Price made a motion to adjourn. Council member Ivey seconded the motion. Mayor Fisher adjourned the meeting at 12:13 P.M.
