MINUTES OF THE CROCKETT CITY COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON THE 12th DAY OF JANUARY 2024 IN THE CITY HALL COUNCIL CHAMBERS, LOCATED AT 200 NORTH FIFTH IN THE CITY OF CROCKETT, HOUSTON COUNTY TEXAS AT 2:00 P.M.

THE COUNCIL MET IN SPECIAL SESSION WITH THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS PRESENT: IANTHIA FISHER, DENNIS IVEY, ERNEST JACKSON & MIKE MARSH. CITY OFFICIALS PRESENT: CITY ADMINISTRATOR JOHN ANGERSTEIN AND CITY SECRETARY MITZI STEFKA. DARRELL JONES AND MARQUITA BEASLEY WERE ABSENT.

OPEN MEETING WITH INVOCATION AND PLEDGE

Mayor Fisher called the formal session open; Council member Ivey gave the invocation, and all joined in the pledge.

RECOGNITION OF VISITORS

Mayor Fisher recognized all visitors present.

COMMENTS FROM AUDIENCE OR COUNCIL (At this time, anyone will be allowed to speak on City related matters only; no personnel matters or matters under litigation will be allowed. The length of time may not exceed three minutes. NO Council discussion or action may take place on a matter until such matter has been placed on an agenda and posted in accordance with law.)

Mayor Fisher expressed appreciation to Mayor Pro Tem Marsh for his dedication to his constituents.

BUSINESS

1. PUBLIC HEARING ON ESTABLISHING NEW PRECINCT BOUNDARY LINES

Mayor Fisher opened the public hearing and invited comments from the audience. With no comments, Mayor Fisher closed the public hearing.

2. CONSIDER AND APPROVE AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CROCKETT, TEXAS, APPROVING THE REDISTRICTING OF THE CITY'S SINGLE-MEMBER COUNCIL PRECINCTS AND ESTABLISHING NEW PRECINCT BOUNDARY LINES BASED ON 2020 CENSUS DATA FOR THE CITY OF CROCKETT, TEXAS CITY COUNCIL ELECTIONS; MAKING VARIOUS FINDINGS AND PROVISIONS RELATED TO THE SUBJECT AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

Mr. Angerstein explained the urgency of approving this ordinance before upcoming election deadlines. Mayor Pro Tem Marsh made a motion to approve an Ordinance of the City council of the City of Crockett, Texas, approving the redistricting of the city's single member council precincts (Exhibit B) and establishing new precinct boundary lines based on 2020 census data for the City of Crockett, Texas city council elections; making

various findings and provisions related to the subject and providing for an effective date. Council member Ivey seconded the motion. Motion passes 3-0.
