CONSIDER AND APPROVE DECLARING A 2014 TAHOE VIN# 1GNLC2E05ER203579 AS SURPLUS AND APPROVE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH CROCKETT INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE PURCHASE OF SAME Mayor Pro Tem Marsh made a motion to approve declaring a 2014 Chevrolet Tahoe VIN # 1GNLC2E05ER203579 as surplus and approve interlocal agreement with Crockett Independent School District for the purchase of same. Council member Hicks seconded the motion. Motion passes 3-0.

## 10. CONSIDER AND APPROVE LOCATIONS OF GATEWAY SIGNS AND ALLOW CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ORDER SURVEYS AND EXECUTE EASEMENT AGREEMENTS
