## **Survey Design Practices**

- 1. <u>Define Clear Objectives:</u> Clearly articulate the purpose of the survey to guide question development and ensure the collected data meets your goals.
  - a. Do not make any answers besides demographics required
  - b. Provide a clear explanation as to what the survey results will be used for
- 2. <u>Keep It Concise</u>: Limit the survey length to encourage higher response rates. Surveys should ideally take no longer than 12 minutes to complete.
- 3. <u>Use Simple and Direct Language:</u> Craft questions that are easily understood to avoid confusion and ensure accurate responses.
- 4. <u>Employ a Variety of Question Types</u>: Incorporate both open-ended and close-ended questions to gather quantitative and qualitative data.
- 5. <u>Avoid Leading or Biased Questions:</u> Ensure questions are neutral to prevent influencing respondents' answers.
- 6. <u>Pilot Test the Survey:</u> Conduct a pretest with a small group to identify and rectify any issues before full deployment.
- 7. <u>Ensure Anonymity and Confidentiality:</u> Assure respondents that their answers will remain confidential to encourage honesty.
- 8. <u>Optimize for Mobile Devices</u>: Design the survey to be accessible on various devices to reach a broader audience
