- Installation & replacement of Units #2 and #3 week of 3/17/2025.


### **Splash Pad**

  - One week delay due to spring break.





  - We were able to plant 188 trees in approximately 4 hours.

      all the trees & irrigation. The Parks &
      Recreation Department covered the
      cost of the fencing, t-posts, and water
      for three(3) years. \*Three years is the
      amount of time needed to ensure the
