Now be it and it is hereby ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Cartersville, that the <u>CITY OF CARTERSVILLE CODE OF ORDINANCES. CHAPTER 24 – UTILITIES. ARTICLE IX. – GAS SYSTEM. DIVISION 1. – GENERALLY. SEC. 24-212. RESERVED.</u> is hereby amended by deleting said section in its entirety and replacing it as follows:

1.

Sec. 24-212. Capacity beyond existing contracts.

In the event a new customer or existing customer needs capacity for natural gas beyond the City's existing capacity or which impacts our ability to provide capacity for preplanned system growth or which impacts the City's reserves of gas capacity, the City may at its discretion, enter into a contract with a natural gas supplier to provide said capacity. The customer shall be required to provide adequate assurance of payment for the entirety of the contract of all of the City's obligations under said natural gas supply contract by an insurance bond, letter of credit, guaranty or cash deposit as determined by the City after reviewing the financial strength and stability of said customer and the adequate assurance of payment.

It is the intention of the city council and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances, City of Cartersville, Georgia, and the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered and/or alphabetized accordingly to accomplish such intention.
